Weekly Report of Israeli violations in the Occupied Palestinian Territories

Summary:

Israeli forces continue their systematic crimes in the West Bank during the reporting period (7-13 December 2017), where the department of documentation and publishing in the CWRC monitored a new Israeli violation on the Palestinians, their land and holy places, which came after the ominous US declaration of Jerusalem as "the capital of Israel" in a new shock to the peace process, from who claimed that he is the first sponsor of peace in the Middle East. also it expected of the United States to establish its embassy on private land for three Palestinian families in Jerusalem.

The report also documented the clashes with the Israeli occupation forces in response to the recent US President's decision which caused the martyrdom of 5 Palestinians, 4 of which from Gaza Strip, and a woman (60) years old who died of a heart attack after throwing a sound bomb on her house by the IOF IN Zbidat village in the northern Jordan valley, in addition to wounded 1,200 people, 170 of which with live bullets in the clashes with the IOF in different cities of the West Bank.

As for the colonial expansion, the Israeli construction minister decided a plan to build 14,000 housing units in Jerusalem, including 7,000 units in East Jerusalem colonies, distributed on 5,000 units in the colony of Atarot on Qalandiya lands, 2,000 in the colony of Pisgat Ze'ev, 5,000 units in Ketmun and 2,000 units in the Rechis Laffan neighborhood.

While for the first time in 20 years, a second colonial city will be established on the lands of Salfit and Qalqilya governorates.

The Interior Ministry's committee has recommended to the official government bodies of the Israeli government to build a major colonial city by merging four colonies, "Oranit, Sh'ari Takva, Elkana and Ats Efraim", and building hundreds of colonial units in the land separating these colonies. The land belongs to citizens of the towns of Massha, Sennaria and Azzun Atma in Qalqilya and Salfit governorates.

And another plan to build 146 new colonial units in the Tsurim neighborhood in the Har Brakha colony on the lands of Nablus.
