## Editorial:

The frequency of the attacks of the colonizers and the militias of the Israeli occupying state escalated this month to record levels, compared to previous months. As a result, the Palestinian citizen paid a heavy price for his personal security, life and property. And while the Israeli occupying power is trying to make Palestinian blood a propaganda material for the elections to be held this week, where in light of this, it pushes the frenzied militias of its colonizers and releases the fists of its soldiers on the trigger towards the steadfast citizens on their land, to form in the end a new Palestinian massacre that will be added to the record of the great altar of freedom for this people.

The machine of repression and killing did not stop at the limits of its attacks on the field only, but reached the stage of explicit incitement against the institutions of the Palestinian popular resistance, on top of which is the Colonization & Wall Resistance Commission and its staff working in the field and among the citizens. Where the extremist colonizers incite against the commission in one of the manifestations of Zionist terrorism through their newspapers and websites, and because the equation of the relationship between the Israeli official institution and the extremist colonists is clear and well-known, the commission views with danger the escalation of incitement campaigns that always receive a great response from the official Israeli institution, but the commission and its cadres at the same time, will remain on its way to achieving its goals by overthrowing the colonial settlement project and restoring the land until last inch.

## First: Assault on Palestinian individuals & properties

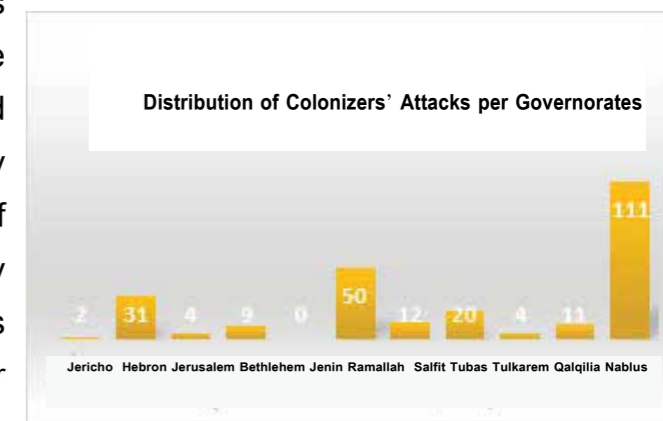
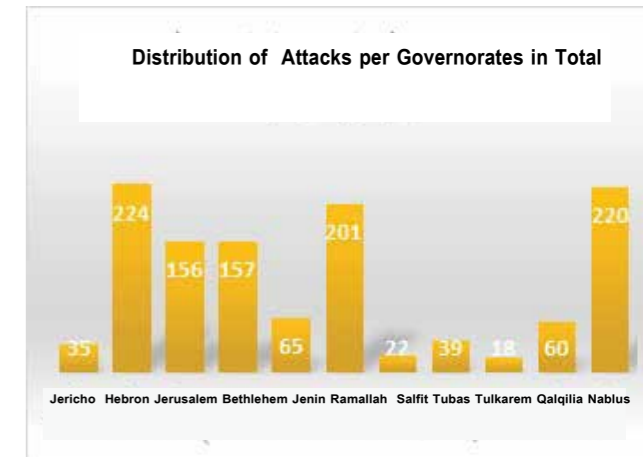
During the period covered by the report in October 2022, the Commission monitored a total of 1,197 violations. These attacks affected individuals, property, land and natural resources, and were concentrated total in the governorates of Hebron, Ramallah, Nablus and Bethlehem. During the aforementioned period, these attacks included the death of 21 Palestinian martyrs in the governorates of Jenin, Ramallah, Nablus, Jerusalem, Jericho, Bethlehem, Hebron, Qalqilya and Salfit . These attacks took different forms, as the colonizers carried out 254 attacks, where the number of attacks on property and land reached 238 attacks, in which there were 28 demolitions that caused the demolition of 43 facilities and sources of livelihood, and 170 cases of vandalism and destruction of property and crops belonging to citizens, as well as 24 cases of property confiscation. Most of them are classified as agricultural properties, including brooks, tents and tractors.

### ● Colonizers attacks

In the period covered by the report, the colonizers carried out a total of 254 attacks that took the nature of organized crime against Palestinian citizens and their property, according to what was monitored by the CWRC, and perhaps the most prominent of these attacks are the major attacks carried out by colonizers against the town of Hawara in Nablus governorate on Thursday and Friday, October 13-14, 2022.

The colonizers' attacks on the town of Hawara / Nablus governorate were as follows:

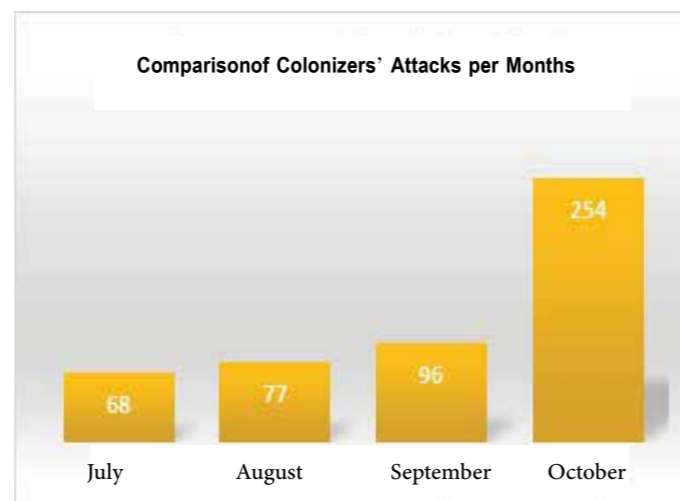
- 26 cases of assault on cars by breaking windows, puncturing wheels, burning an entire truck and a bus.
- 13 cases of home assault and windows breaking.
- 7 cases of assault on shops, including the burning of an entire cafe.
- 6 injuries among the citizens necessitated their transfer to the hospital.
- 16 cases of burning of lands resulted in torching of 610 olive trees.

The colonizers' attacks for the month of October were concentrated in Nablus governorate with 111 attacks, Ramallah with 50 attacks, and Hebron with 31 attacks, which are the areas surrounded by colonies that are considered the most extreme and ferocious, and the home of the "hilltop youth" and "price tag" terrorist colonial groups.

#### Escalation of colonizers attacks:

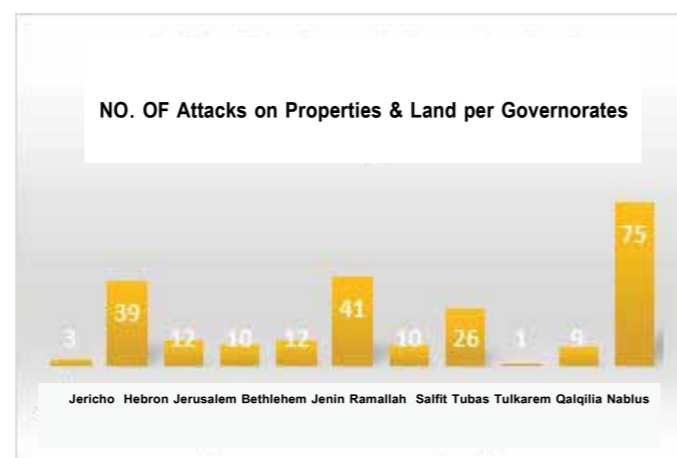
The latest data on the colonizers attacks shows a significant and dangerous increase, specifically in the last month of October 2022, as the number of violations reached 254, compared to 96 attacks in the previous month, 77 in the month before, etc.

The data also indicate the dangerous role that the colonizers have played through direct shooting at Palestinian citizens, and the formation of armed militias that aim to destabilize the Palestinian presence, the latest of which has become known as the "Civil Guard" and the tasks assigned to it is to terrorize the Palestinians in Palestinian villages and gatherings, with the protection, support and facilitation of the Israeli occupying army and the official institutions.



#### ● Attacks on property and land

The teams of the CWRC managed, during last October, to record 238 cases of attacks on the lands and properties of Palestinian citizens. These attacks included the bulldozing of approximately 139 dunums of land in Tubas, Hebron, Nablus and Ramallah governorates, and the implementation of 28 demolitions that affected the property of citizens and caused the demolition of 43 facilities and sources of livelihood. The Israeli occupation authorities issued 12 demolition notifications. These attacks focused on Nablus governorate with 75 attacks, followed by Ramallah with 41 attacks, then Jerusalem with 39 attacks.

#### ● Attacks on trees:

The CWRC monitored, during the period targeted by the report, a total of 1,584 trees were cut down and uprooted by the colonizers' militias, all of which were olive trees. Most of these attacks focused on Nablus governorate with uprooting 950 trees, Hebron governorate with uprooting 408 trees, and Tubas governorate with 100 trees.

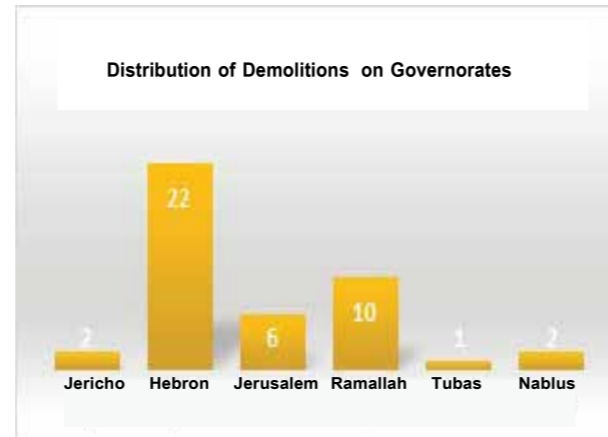

**Demolitions:**

The number of demolitions carried out by the Israeli occupation forces during October 2022 reached a total of 28 demolitions of houses, commercial establishments and sources of livelihood, which caused the demolition of a total of 43 facilities and sources of livelihood. These operations were concentrated in Hebron governorate with 14 demolitions that caused the demolition of 11 facilities, Jerusalem with 6 operations that caused the demolition of 6 facilities, and Ramallah with 3 operations that caused the demolition of 10 facilities.

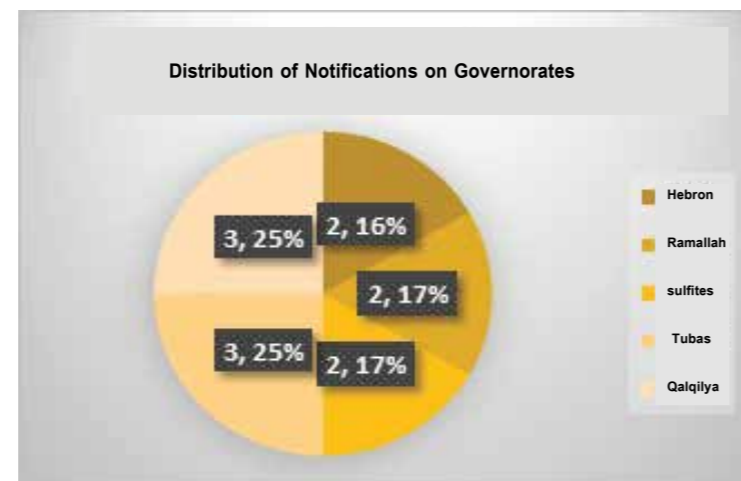

**Notifications (demolition, construction halt, eviction) in the West Bank**

In the month of October, the Israeli authorities issued 12 notifications, ranging from demolition notices (2 demolitions) to construction halt notices (8 notices) and evacuating Palestinian structures on the pretext of non-licensing (3 evictions).



Most of these notifications are concentrated in the governorates of Qalqilya (3 notifications) and Tubas (3 notifications). These notifications issued by the occupation authorities in the West Bank are considered one of the tools of the occupation in besieging the Palestinians in Area C and preventing them from development and urban expansion, in light of the occupation's control over planning in those areas, the Palestinians were denied the right to prepare structural plans and were not approved if they were submitted to them in order to exploit Area C, which represents 61% of the area of the West Bank, and keep it for the expansion of colonies and as a strategic reserve for them in the future.

**First: The approved and proposed (deposited) colonial expansion plans in the West Bank for the month of October 2022.**

**Approved plans:**

The occupation authorities have approved (3) new colonial plans, with the aim of expanding into existing colonies (according to the occupation claim), targeting the lands of Palestinian citizens, as they seek to build more public buildings.

The occupation authorities have deposited (8) new colonial plans, targeting (9.792) dunums, and seeking to build (77) new colonial units.

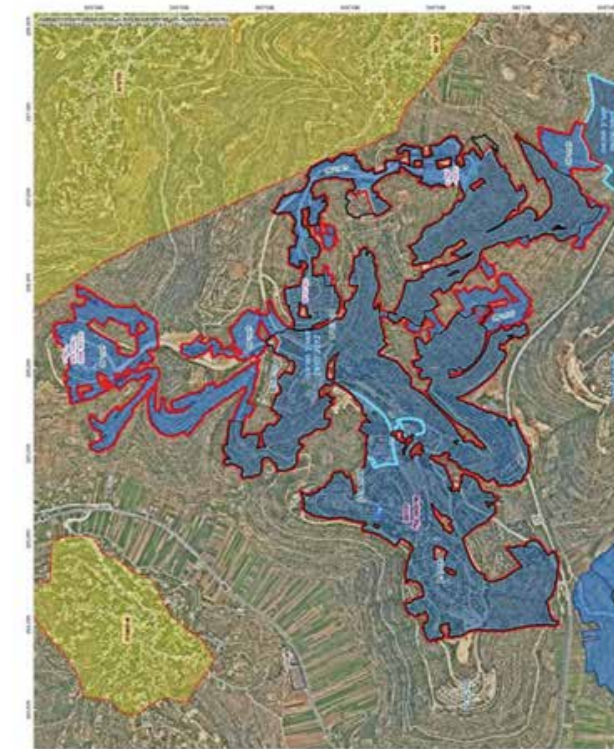

● **Second: Permitting colonial planning on Palestinian lands**

On October 25, 2022, the Infrastructure Department of the Occupational Civil Administration announced that it would allow the amendment of the “Eli” colony area of influence, and accordingly, a total of 616 dunums of the citizens’ lands that were previously declared as state lands will be added to become part of the “Eli colony” area of influence, from the lands of the citizens in Qaryut, Laban and Al- Sawiya in Nablus governorate.

**Third: racist incitement and statements in the Israeli media:**

The websites of the Israeli leaders and the colonizers were filled with direct incitement against Palestinian citizens, whether with racist incitements or those that encourages colonial construction and the theft of Palestinian land. Perhaps the most prominent manifestations of incitement are those that seriously incite against the CWRC and its working staff, especially the head of the commission, Muayyad Shaaban. In this part of the report, we show these incitements and the most prominent of them:

■ 10\6\2022: Benjamin Netanyahu, the leader of the Israeli opposition, pledged to build more colonies in the West Bank if re-elected. Israeli opposition leader Benjamin Netanyahu has pledged to support massive housing construction in West Bank settlements if he regains his position as prime minister after the November Israeli elections. Netanyahu signed with 30 members of the Likud party and 26 other politicians from Shas, United Torah Judaism, the “Religious Zionist Party” and “Jewish Home” a statement of intention for the “Movement for Sovereignty” with the aim of developing colonies and building more of them. A statement issued by the “Move East” campaign, led by the Movement for Sovereignty, said that the best solution to the housing crisis is to build in the West Bank, and the statement continued “The risk of housing prices in the center of the country necessitates massive construction in the neighboring area, Judea and Samaria” .

The statement said, “The construction of thousands of houses on the Tel Aviv–Ariel axis will lead to a significant increase in the supply of construction lands and a significant decrease in housing prices”.

■ 10/18/2022: Ittar bin Ghafir, an extremist member of the Israeli Knesset, said: I will work to create the national authority to encourage immigration, and we will work to remove the “enemies” of Israel from the land of Israel.

■ 10/18/2022: Mikhail bin Ari, from the leaders of the “Jewish Force”; party, stated that he will encourage the displacement of the Arabs from Umm al –Fahm, who dance on the surfaces when the “saboteurs” kill Jews.

■ 10/18/2022: Ittar bin Ghafir published on Friday a tweet calling for the killing of residents of the Palestinian neighborhood. He posted a picture of his children, who were fooling with a plastic machine gun, attaching a phrase “After the riots in Shimon (Sheikh Jarrah) I took children to games to teach them what to do with the “terrorists” as he stated.

■ 10/25/2022: The Jewish Voice website published an article by “Shalom Friedman” about the activities of the CWRC, and the article concluded with the following statement: In the forum “The Struggle for Every Dunum”, they said in response, “Instead of shooting at the feet of rioters And arresting this group of terrorists immediately (they mean the staff of the commission), it is time for the Israeli army to realize that this is nothing less than a terrorist organization behind most of the riots in Judea and Samaria.”

■ 10/23/2022: The Jewish Voice website published another article by “Shalom Friedman” about the commission in which he incited against Muayyad Shaaban, we quote here this paragraph: ““The serious and inflammatory words of Shaaban, who called for the formation of a committee to start an uprising against the Jewish people, are further evidence of the danger of the man who roams freely throughout Judea and Samaria. “This is the man who heads the violent commission “the CWRC” and for months, along with its members, has been leading a series of violent riots every week against Jewish colonies and the Israeli security forces. They made it clear at the forum that the security service must come to its senses and act immediate–
