

Forward


The Israeli occupation's official sponsorship of the settler-colonial project and the colonizers' terrorism has never been more apparent. The occupation state presents itself now, more than ever, as one of the last fascist regimes of the new age, with full-fledged criminality, carried out in broad daylight and implemented by direct, clear instructions from leaders and ministers in the occupation government. This is to complete the functional circle provided by the occupation state in the declared exchange of roles between the occupation army and its colonial militia on the ground. Perhaps what happened in the villages south of Nablus, specifically in the town of Huwwara on the night of the 26th of February is the most comprehensive and clear example of the exchange of roles at hand and the overt issue of crime and terrorism sponsorship.

The recent Israeli occupation government, especially the rise of the leaders of the Zionist terrorist parties to power, helped unveil the ugly face of the occupation in an unprecedented manner. Through this report, the Colonization and Wall Resistance Commission aspires to shed light on the crimes of the occupation and the reality of its criminality in front of the world with the ultimate goal of attaining justice for the crimes committed by the occupying state.

First: Attacks on Individuals and Properties

The Colonization and Wall Resistance Commission (CWRC) documented 636 violations in February of 2023. These violations affected individuals, property, lands, and



natural resources and they were concentrated in the governorates of Ramallah, Hebron, and Nablus. During the aforementioned period, 30 Palestinians were killed in these attacks in the governorates of Jericho, Jerusalem, Tubas, Jenin, Hebron, Salfit, Nablus, and Jenin¹.

These violations took on different forms. The colonizers carried out 271 attacks, while the attacks on property and land amounted to 364 attacks, in which 51 demolitions occurred. These demolitions caused the destruction of 69 facilities and sources of livelihood. There were also 195 cases of vandalism and destruction of property and crops belonging to citizens. There were also 23 cases of confiscation of property, most of which are classified as agricultural properties, including barracks, tents, and tractors.

• Colonizers' Attacks

The Colonization and Wall Resistance Commission documented 271 colonizers' attacks during the period covered by the report. These attacks took on the shape of organized crime against Palestinians and their properties. Perhaps the most prominent of these attacks took place in the villages south of Nablus, particularly in the town of Huwwara. These attacks were distributed as follows.

There were 142 colonizers' attacks in many villages in Nablus Governorate that were distributed as follows



Attempts at establishing 5 colonial outposts that were distributed as follows

- Establishing a sheepfold to the east of Ain al-Hilwah in the Bayoud area by colonizers with 40 sheep Tubas.
- Establishing a colonial outpost by building barracks in the east of Ramon Ramallah.
- Establishing a colonial outpost by building barracks east of Kafr Malik Ramallah.
- The colonizers re-established a colonial outpost in Al-Qaboun, east of Al-Mughayyir Ramallah, even though it was removed back in 2015. This controls thousands of dunums in "Ghawr Addaliyah" to tighten their control over the area.
- colonizers from the "Elie Zahav" colony, established on the lands of Kafr El-Deek town Salfit, seized an area of citizens' lands in the northern part of the town, known as the "Balat Rokuba" (Khallet Al-Qamih) area, fenced it off, and established a cemetery to bury their dead in it.

6 Cases of Land-Levelling

• The Israeli occupation forces began implementing a land-leveling operation in the western side of Marda village — Salfit, to extend water lines for the benefit of the



company of "Mekorot". The area of land that may be affected by the implementation of this project is estimated to be hundreds of dunums, in addition to the uprooting of hundreds of fruitful perennial trees. This will be done in favor of the Israeli colony built on privately owned lands in the governorate.

- A colonizer has bulldozed 200 square meters of agricultural land in Khallet Wazen, east of the industrial zone in as-Samou' Hebron.
- Land-levelling and uprooting of trees in Qusra Nablus.
- The Israeli occupation forces bulldozed the road leading to the cemetery in the area of Summe' and stone retaining walls in Al-Walaja Bethlehem.
- The Israeli occupation forces excavated the lands of citizens near the colonial outpost "Migron Zvi" established on private lands in the area of Birin, northeast of Yatta Hebron for the purpose of colonial expansion.
- Land-levelling of lands in the village of Shufa southeast of Tulkarm, located in the area of Mount "Al-Maraabei" south of the village.
- Attacks on Properties and Land
- The Colonization and Wall Resistance Commission's crews were able to document 364 attacks on the lands and properties of citizens during

February of 2022. These attacks included the bulldozing of about 620 dunums of land in Salfit, Hebron, Nablus, and Tulkarm².

• Attacks on Trees

The Colonization and Wall Resistance Commission's crews were able to document the cutting down and uprooting of 562 trees by colonizers' militia during February of 2022. Most of these attacks were concentrated in the Ramallah governorate with the uprooting of 174 trees, followed by the Hebron governorate with the uprooting of 170 trees.

- Demolitions

The number of demolitions perpetrated by the Israeli occupation forces during

February 2023 was of a total of 56 operations, which caused the demolition of a total of 69 of houses, commercial establishments and sources of livelihood. These demolitions were concentrated in Jerusalem governorate with demolished facilities, and Nablus governorate with 14 demolished facilities³.






- Notifications (demolition, construction moratoriums) in the West Bank

Last February, the Israeli occupation authorities issued 66 notices to demolish, halt construction, and evacuate Palestinian facilities. These



notices varied between orders to demolish or halt construction under the pretext of non-licensing and eviction orders under the pretext of military training. Most of them were concentrated in the governorates of Jenin, with 31 notifications, and Salfit with 9 notifications.

These notifications issued by the Israeli occupation authorities in the West Bank are considered one of the colonial tools in besieging the Palestinians in Area C and preventing them from urban development and expansion where the occupation control over planning in those areas and preventing the Palestinians from their right to prepare master plans and rejecting them if they are submitted, in order to exploit Area C, which represents 61% of the area of the West Bank, However, the Israeli Occupation seeks to keep this area for the expansion of colonies or as a strategic reserve for them in the future.

Second: Israeli occupation measures regarding colonial expansion

1: Decisions of the Israeli occupation government:

Session 7/2/2023

- Changing the name of the Ministry of Immigrants to the Ministry of Immigrants and Fighting Semitism and transferring the powers of fighting boycotting Israel and its illegality to the new ministry instead of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- The government decided to extend the validity of the Nationality and Entry into Israel Law (Palestinian family unification law only) until 2024.
- Separating the "Tel Zion" colony from the "Kochav Ya'akov" colony in Binyamin (Ramallah) and turning it into an independent local council.
- Changing the name of the Ministry of Development and Rural (West Bank) to the Ministry of Transport, Galilee, and National Immunity.
- Confiscating equipment for drilling wells in Ashdod port belonging to the Palestinian Authority.

Session 12/2/2023

• The government decided to authorize the Committee of Ministers of National Security, the "security-cabinet", to discuss the issue of establishing new colonies or settling the status of the colonies in "Judea and Samaria".

- Appointing the head of the settlement department in the Ministry of Defense without declaring a "political appointment".
- Decisions of the Israeli security cabinet
- The legalization of the following outposts: Avigail in the southern Hebron Hills, Beit Hoglah in the lands of Jericho, Givat Harel near the colony of Shilo\Turmusaya, Giv'at Arnon between Aqraba and Beit Furik, Mitzvah Yehuda on the lands of Al-Khader, Lahih Hashlom in the lands of the Jordan Valley, and Ashel Turati in the Hebron Hills, Sadeh Boaz in Al-Khader area, Shehret in the town of Kafr Al-Dik.
- Speeding up the meeting of the Supreme Planning Committee in the Civil Administration to approve new housing units for existing colonies.
- Strengthening police forces and border guards in Jerusalem and implementing campaigns to arrest instigators and supporters of terrorism.



3. Approved and proposed (deposited) Colonial Expansion Plans

The Israeli occupation authorities approved (23) new colonial plans, with the aim of conducting an expansion within existing colonies (according to the occupation claim), targeting (1494.954) dunums of Palestinian lands, as it seeks to build (2477) new colonial units. Also, (26) new colonial plans were deposited, targeting (3915.362) dunums, and seeking to build (4625) new colonial units.



Expropriation Orders

The Israeli Occupation Authorities claim, through expropriation orders, that they are confiscating Palestinian lands for the benefit of a public project that serves the public community. When analyzing the term "public", it was found that what is meant here is the "Israeli" public, specifically the colonizers. Last February, the Israeli occupation authorities issued two expropriation orders to confiscate 391 dunums of citizens' lands in Jerusalem and Jericho governorates. The first expropriation order(2/23/•) targeted 139 dunums of Jericho governorate lands and was intended to establish an archaeological site, while the second order (01/23/•) targeted 252 dunums of "Hezma" village, aimed at widening the main road located connecting Hezma town with Jaba' and is specialized for the colonizers.

Thus, the total area of the lands threatened with confiscation in Hezma became more than 500 dunums. These lands belong to the citizens of the town of Hezma. Some of these lands are located within the jurisdiction of the so-called occupation municipality, while the other are located under the area of influence of the Civil Administration.



Racist Public Statements/Discourse by Members of the Israeli Government:

The social media of the occupying power and the colonizers is full with direct racist incitements against the Palestinian citizens that encourage colonial construction and theft of Palestinian land. The most prominent of these incitements are:

• The Israeli finance minister, Bezalel Smotrich said, on 28/2/2023, that Israel should "wipe out" the Palestinian town of Huwara in the West Bank. He added "the State of Israel should do that, not the colonizers".

- The Minister in the occupation government, Ofir Akunis: "there will not be a freeze on the building and development in colonies, not even for one minute. We will establish and expand colonies".
- The Member of Knesset from the Ben Gvir Party, Zvika Vogel, on his personal page, 27/2/2023: "The deterrent actions that the settlers achieved tonight in Huwara have not been achieved by Israel since the Operation of the Defensive Shield. I see an amazing result. I want to see this place burning".
- Yossi Dagan, an Israeli activist politician and the head of the Regional Council, posted on his personal page, 26/2/2023: "I demand the Prime Minister and the Minister of Defense to "turn the table" on the Palestinians, and to launch a military operation immediately. The people of Israel will defeat the barbarians. We demand the Israeli government to adopt a new policy to deal with terrorism and to allow the army to carry out a military strike against Palestinians".
- Itamar Ben-Gvir, the Israeli minister of National Security, during a
 meeting with his far-right "Jewish Strength Party" on 1/2/2023,
 threatened the electric chair death penalty for Palestinians involved in
 attacks against Israelis. "Anyone who murders, harms and slaughters
 civilians should be sent to the electric chair," as cited by Israeli Channel
 13.

• Israel Hayom reported, in 2/2/2023, that Ben-Gvir, the Israeli minister of National Security "went crazy" after learning of the existence of the bakeries. "Prisoners cannot get such a privilege," he was quoted as saying. "How can they get fresh bread every day? What is this absurdity?"
