**Foreword:**

In September, there was a significant increase in attacks by the Israeli military and colonizers against Palestinian civilians and their properties throughout the West Bank, including occupied Jerusalem. This rise in violence is part of a systematic policy aimed at expanding colonial control and creating a new reality on the ground. Daily raids on Palestinian cities and towns continued, accompanied by field arrests, gunfire, the demolition of homes and facilities, and the seizure of land and equipment.

At the same time, the colonizers, supported by the Israeli army, intensified their assaults and attacks through direct physical attacks, the burning of trees, preventing farmers from accessing their lands, and establishing new colonial outposts. These violations highlight a clear connection between the actions of colonizers and the plans of the Israeli occupying state, which offers them protection and encouragement. This situation highlights the deep collaboration between the two sides, the colonizers and the Israeli army, in enforcing policies of forced displacement and colonial expansion.



## First: Violations of the Israeli Occupation State & Colonizers in the Occupied Palestinian Territories in September 2025:

During the reporting period, September 2025, the Colonization & Wall Resistance Commission (CWRC) monitored 2215 attacks.

These attacks were carried out by the various bodies of the Israeli occupying state, including its colonial militia, against Palestinian citizens and their properties.




Of these, 1725 attacks were carried out by the Israeli army, while the colonizers perpetrated 490 attacks

These attacks included assaults and physical injuries, caused by live ammunition, gas, or terrorism. They also involved raids, vandalism, theft, property confiscation, land bulldozing, uprooting trees, and imposing closures and barriers that undermine the unity of Palestinian geography

However, the majority of these attacks occurred in the governorate of Ramallah which witnessed 417 attacks. This was followed by Nablus Governorate which witnessed 309 attacks. These governorates experienced intensive attacks, amounting to 54% of the total attacks. The other governorates faced a similarly difficult situation. The governorates of Bethlehem and Jerusalem experienced over 100 attacks each.

These attacks included 461 attacks on property and holy places, 94 attacks on lands and natural resources, and 1660 attacks on citizens.


A comparison of the total Israeli violations during the past three months:



### **Attacks Perpetrated by the Israeli Occupation State & Colonizers against Palestinian Citizens, their Properties and Holy Places.**

#### **Attacks on citizens:**

During the reporting period, September 2025, the Colonization & Wall Resistance Commission (CWRC) documented 1660 attacks on citizens. Most of these attacks were concentrated in Ramallah & al Bireh Governorate which




witnessed 335 attacks, followed by Nablus Governorate which witnessed 215 attacks. These attacks included shooting, arrest campaigns, shutting down checkpoints, intimidation, and imposing traffic restrictions on citizens.

**Attacks on Lands & Natural Resources:**

In September 2025, the Colonization & Wall Resistance Commission (CWRC) has documented 94 attacks on the Palestinian lands and natural resources<sup>1</sup>. These attacks were concentrated



in Hebron governorate which was subjected to 30 attacks, followed by Ramallah & al Bireh governorate where 20 attacks were recorded. Meanwhile, Nablus governorate witnessed 15 attacks.

These attacks affected hundreds of dunums of citizens' lands. During the reporting period, September 2025, there were 11 attempts by colonizers to establish colonial outposts in the governorates of Nablus, Salfit, Qalqilia, Tubas and Hebron. Additionally, the Israeli occupation authorities and colonizers carried out 27 bulldozing lands' operations. These operations were concentrated in Ramallah & al Bireh Governorate, where 9 bulldozing lands' operations took place, followed by Hebron governorate which was subjected to 6 bulldozing lands' operations. Meanwhile, 3 bulldozing lands' operations were recorded in Nablus and Jenin for each.

### **Attacks on Trees:**


During the reporting period, September 2025, the Colonization & Wall Resistance Commission (CWRC) documented 56 attacks on trees that caused the uprooting, poisoning and burning of 431 trees among which there were 261 olive trees. These attacks were concentrated in Ramallah & al Bireh governorate where 11 attacks were recorded, followed by the governorates of Nablus which witnessed 10 attacks.

### Attacks on Palestinian Properties:

In September 2025, the CWRC documented 461 Israeli attacks on Palestinian property. During this period, the occupying army and colonial militias carried out extensive campaigns to confiscate and steal citizens' property.



The targeted properties included vehicles, camera recordings, bulldozers, solar panels, water tanks, livestock, and money. Furthermore, there were 255 incidents of property vandalism and 74 documented incidents of confiscations and thefts of properties during the reporting period.

Specifically, the Israeli forces were involved in the theft of 18 vehicles, one bulldozer, 11 instances of motorcycle confiscation, 1 instance of confiscating surveillance cameras, one agricultural tractor, five bulldozers, one cement mixer, one sheep, various journalistic equipment, one kiosk with electrical supplies, one drone, belongings from two schools and universities, two houses, and one water well. In addition, the colonizers were responsible for the theft of various items, including 184 livestock, two donkeys, two vehicles, one bicycle, three water pumps, three cases of money theft, three incidents involving the theft of house contents, four cases of agricultural equipment theft, two generators, two mobile phones, two cases of crop theft, and one residential tent theft.




**Colonizers' Attacks:** According to what was monitored and documented by the Colonization and Wall Resistance Commission (CWRC) during the reporting period, September 2025, the colonizers carried out 490 organized attacks. These terrorist attacks resulted in the martyrdom of two citizens in the towns of Deir Jarir and Al-Mughayir in Ramallah & Al-Bireh Governorate. The two martyrs are Mu'in Muhammad Alawi from Deir Jarir and Saeed Al-Na'san from Al-Mughayir. They were killed in two direct shooting operations by colonizers.

Furthermore, these attacks varied between the occupation army's protection of the colonists in their storming of Palestinian cities and communities, breaking into Palestinian villages, confiscating citizens' property, drawing racist slogans on the walls, and bulldozing lands, as what happened in the villages of Deir Istia and Deir abu Mesh 'al and other areas.

The most prominent of these colonial attacks was storming the holy places; among which was the squares of Al-Aqsa Mosque in the occupied city of Jerusalem. During the reporting period, September 2025, 7540 Israeli colonizers, protected by the Israeli occupation army, carried out 29 raids into Al-Aqsa Mosque Squares. Besides, 1887 colonizers carried out provocative tours under what is called “tourism to the squares of Al-Aqsa Mosque”. Furthermore, the situation at the Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron sharply deteriorated as occupation authorities implemented restrictions on prayer access and prevented the call to prayer. The Israeli actions taken against al-Ibrahimi Mosque represent a blatant and unprecedented attack, provoking the feelings of Muslims and showing a disregard for the sanctity of religious rituals.

Notably worth, most of these attacks were concentrated in Hebron Governorate which was subjected to 127 attacks, followed by Ramallah & al Bireh governorate where 122 attacks were recorded. Meanwhile, 115 attacks were documented in Nablus governorate.



### Examples on colonizers' attacks carried out in September 2025:

**On September 1, 2025**, a group of colonizers, from the so-called "Asfar" colony set fire to agricultural land in the town of Sa'ir, located northeast of Hebron. They stormed into Wadi Sa'ir and burned extensive areas of land with



grapevines, almond trees, and olive trees, belonging to al Shalalda and Tarwa families, among others. Residents of Sa'ir stated that the ongoing colonizers' attacks aim to displace Palestinians from their land to facilitate the colonial expansion. They noted that these continues attacks, which are usually perpetrated by colonizers from the so-called "Asfar and Kodovim", also include the theft of dozens of sheep.



**On September 10, 2025**, a group of colonizers set up mobile homes (caravans) on land belonging to the village of Al-Rihya, located south of Hebron. This took place in Khallat al-Ma'aser area, near the so-called "Hagai" colony. The purpose of this action was to expand the colony at the expense of land owned by Al-Tubasi

family. Additionally, the colonizers constructed a road to connect this colony with the newly established caravans. In total, the land seized by the colonizers is about 150 dunams.

**On September 11, 2025**, a group of colonizers attacked the town of Atara, located north of Ramallah. They attempted to set fire to a vehicle, causing damage to its exterior, and they wrote racist slogans on the walls of a house belonging to the citizen Rami Sarhanah.





**September 13, 2025:** The young man, Muhammad Issa Ahmad Alawi (21 years old), was martyred after being shot by colonizers in the village of Deir Jarir, east of Ramallah. They opened fire on a group of young men on the road connecting the village to the

neighboring town of Silwad, resulting in his injury. He was subsequently transferred to the Palestine Medical Complex in Ramallah, where he was pronounced martyred from his wounds.

**On September 21, 2025,** a group of colonizers stole a residential tent and agricultural equipment in Al-Jubiya area near As-Sakout, located in the northern Jordan Valley. Recently, there has been a noticeable increase in attacks by colonizers against Palestinian citizens and their property. These incidents include physical assaults, depriving citizens from accessing to their lands, theft of livestock, and acts of arson. As a result of these attacks, three Palestinian communities have been forced to evacuate since last summer, and others have experienced partial evacuations for similar reasons.

**On September 23, 2025,** the citizen Saeed Murad Naasan, 20, was martyred by gunfire from colonizers in the town of Al-Mughayyir, located northeast of Ramallah. During the same violent attack by Israeli occupation forces and colonizers, several other Palestinians were injured. Reports indicate



that the colonizers, under the protection of Israeli forces, assaulted a public park in the southeastern part of the village and opened fire on Palestinians, leading to the young man's martyrdom.




On September 25, 2025, a group of colonizers attacked Palestinian-owned land in the Al-Jiza area in Farkha village, located south of Salfit. Reports indicated that the colonizers demolished over 200 meters of stone

walls north of the village. This incident marks the third such attack in the area, which has involved the demolition of walls and the uprooting of olive trees.

## Second: Procedures and Practices of the Occupation Authorities against Palestinian Facilities

### A. Demolitions:

According to the violations' database of the CWRC, and during the reporting period, September 2025, the Israeli occupation authorities carried out 67 demolitions that targeted 94 facilities in the West Bank, including Jerusalem. Most of these demolitions were concentrated in Hebron Governorate, which witnessed 25




demolitions that resulted in the demolition of 35 facilities followed by Jerusalem Governorate, where 14 demolitions were monitored and resulted in the demolitions of 15 facilities. Meanwhile, 10 demolitions were recorded in Salfit governorate and caused the demolition of 10 facilities.

Because the relationship between demolitions and demolition notifications is inherent (see the notifications section), we notice the concentration (of both demolitions and notifications) in the southern areas of the West Bank. These notifications are concentrated in vast areas where the Israeli occupation seeks to evacuate and forcibly depopulate in favor of the settler-colonial project. During the reporting period, these demolitions included: inhabited residences, uninhabited residences, residences under construction, agricultural facilities, mobile homes (caravans), industrial and commercial barracks, and water wells.



## B. Notifications (Demolition, Construction Moratorium, and Evacuation)

During the reporting period, September 2025, Israeli occupation authorities issued 35 notifications, including notifications of demolition, construction moratorium orders due to lack of permits, and eviction notifications under the pretext of military training. The majority of these notifications were concentrated in Hebron



Governorate, which received 12 notifications, followed by Jerusalem Governorate, which had 9 notifications. Meanwhile, Bethlehem governorate received 6 notifications.

These demolition notifications issued by the Israeli occupation authorities in the West Bank serve as one of the means they utilize to restrict Palestinians in Area “C” and obstruct their development and urban expansion. In light of the Israeli occupation’s control of planning in these areas, they deprive Palestinians from their right to prepare master plans. Even if these master plans are submitted, they are rejected, the thing which prevents Palestinians from utilizing Area “C”, taking into consideration that area “C” constitutes 61% of the West Bank lands. This area is being kept for the expansion of colonies and as a strategic reserve for future use.

### **Third: Land Expropriation (Land Confiscation)**

In September 2025, the occupation authorities seized a total of 494,996 dunums of citizens’ land through 3 land seizure orders for military purposes. These were seized for the aim of establishing a barbed-wire fence on the lands of Kafr Al-Deik, a buffer zone around the colony Nahliel near Beitillu, and another fence on the lands of Ni’lin and Deir Qaddis. The occupation also issued a state land declaration targeting 445 dunums for the purpose of legalizing the status of the Havat Gil’ad colonial outpost established on lands east of Qalqilia and west of Nablus. The occupation forces also issued an order to confiscate a total of 288 meters from the rooftop of the inner courtyard of the Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron under the pretext of expropriation for public interest. This decision comes as a part of the continued effort to strip the Palestinian authorities of jurisdiction over the holy sites, especially the Ibrahimi Mosque and grant it to settler-colonial institutions.

**First order:** The occupation forces seized an area of 11.337 dunums of land belonging to the towns of Ni’lin and Deir Qaddis in the Ramallah Governorate for military and security purposes carrying the number




T/162/25. The military order aims to establish a barbed-wire fence to the north of the Mattityahu colony.



**Second order:** The occupation forces issued a seizure order for an area of 8.964 dunums belonging to the lands of Beitillu in the Ramallah Governorate for military and security purposes. The military order, carrying the number T/5/7 amends a previous order issued in 2007 by adding the aforementioned area to a previously seized area for the purpose of completing a

buffer zone around the colony of Giv'at Minahim.

**Third order:** The occupation forces issued a seizure order of an area of 3.649 dunums belonging to the lands of Kafr Al-Deik in the Salfit Governorate, under the pretext of an “order to take possession for military and security purposes”. This order carried the number M.D/8/25 and aims to construct a barbed-wire fence in the buffer zone between Kafr Al-Deik village and the Eli Zahav colony.



**Fourth order:** The Israeli occupation authorities seized an area of 455.58 dunums land belonging to Jeet and Far'ata, east of the Qalqilya Governorate, and Til, west of the Nablus Governorate. The seizure was put forth under a new declaration labelled “state land”. This order carried the number 2/25 and targeted the area where the


colonial outpost of Havat Gil'ad was illegally established in 2003 on the lands of Jeet, Far'ata, and Til. Through this seizure, the occupation authorities aim to legalize the aforementioned colonial outpost, knowing that the occupation government intended to legalize it several years ago.

### **Fifth order: Seizure of the Rooftop of the Ibrahimi Mosque**

The occupation authorities issued a military order to seize the rooftop of the inner courtyard of the Ibrahimi Mosque in the city of Hebron, through an expropriation order that orders to seize an area of 288 meters of the mosque's rooftop.

With this, the occupation state takes a gradually escalating approach that targets holy places, violating all norms, especially by transferring all authority in the Ibrahimi Mosque in February of 2025 from the Palestinian Ministry of Endowment to the occupation's so-called "Central Planning Bureau". This was followed by another decision on July 20, 2025 to withdraw the supervisory powers from the Hebron Municipality and transfer them to the religious council in the colony of Kiryat Arba' to manage a part of the mosque and enforce structural changes within it.

This decision, that coincides with the transfer of the supervisory powers from the Palestinian Ministry of Endowment and the Hebron Municipality to colonial bodies, entrenches an approach that aims to undermine the Islamic religious sovereignty over the Ibrahimi Mosque and legitimizes the direct colonial intervention in the management of its facilities and buildings, in addition to isolating the Mosque from its Palestinian



surrounding and linking it both administratively and security-wise to colonial councils.

#### **Fourth: Colonial Expansion Plans / legalizing outposts**

Last September, the planning authorities in the occupation state studied 19 master plans in favor of the West Bank colonies and within the municipal boundaries of the occupation municipality in occupied Jerusalem. 14 master plans were studied of the West Bank colonies while 5 were studied for occupied Jerusalem colonies within municipal boundaries.

The planning authorities in the occupation state approved 7 master plans for West Bank colonies and deposited 7 others, approving the construction of 60 new colonial units and depositing 880 others on an area of 954 dunums.

The occupation municipality in occupied Jerusalem approved 2 master plan and deposited 3 others in favor of occupied Jerusalem colonies within municipal boundaries, with new 538 colonial units. This plan targeted 20 dunums of citizens' lands.

#### **First: Master Plans in the West Bank**

The maps attached to the master plans showcase that occupation authorities' approval of a plan to establish an industrial zone on the lands of the Libban Al-Gharbi Town in the Ramallah Governorate and the Deir Ballout Town in the Salfit Governorate spanning over 655 dunums on privately owned citizens' lands. The master plan, carrying the number ת/יוש /202 was deposited and studied multiple times, first of which was in February 2025.

The planning authorities of the occupation state, represented by the District Committee of the Jerusalem Municipality, reviewed a total of 5 master plans aimed at colonial expansion in the colonies established in Jerusalem. They approved 2 plans and deposited 3 others, amounting to 538 colonial units. This took place on an area estimated at 20.167 dunums of citizens' land.

### Fifth : Attitudes and Racist Statements by Prominent Characters in the Israeli Occupation State

**These days, leaders of the Israeli occupation have started making their racist statements unabashedly, revealing their superiority complexes and racist**

**stances. In this section of the report, we quickly review the most prominent statements.**

- On September 3, 2025, Tsvi Sukkot stated: “as long as supporters of terrorism live there [Gaza], complete demilitarization, Jewish immigration and settlement.”<sup>2</sup>
- On September 4, 2025, Amihai Eliyahu, the so-called Minister of Heritage said: “We are not annexing, because annexing is something that is not ours. We are applying sovereignty to areas that were ours in the past in the land of our ancestors.”<sup>3</sup>
